Fuzzy Friends Rescue has created a new program where pet owners can be assured that beyond their lifetime, their beloved animals will continue to enjoy life in a loving and caring environment.

One of the greatest gifts of love that anyone can give a companion animal is to make certain that they are cared for if something should happen. Many people think that their family or their friends will care for their beloved friends. Unfortunately, that oftentimes does not happen.

We are contacted often by Waco area residents who are in search peace of mind for themselves – and more importantly, in search of a loving home for their pet once they are disabled or pass away.

The immediate goal is to provide interim or permanent care for beloved pets who have lost their parent(s) due to medical reasons or death. We'll place the pet(s) in a permanent home and make sure the pet receives the same standard of care and love received in his/her primary home. Or, depending on the owner's wishes or the animal's needs, FFR will care for the pet for its entire lifetime.

Enrollment Details:

Under this program, pet owners pay a one-time enrollment fee, and make either a one-time payment or an estate gift either through their Will or life insurance policy. Minimum enrollment rates include:

Enrollment fees, cash payments, estate gift and life insurance gifts are NON-REFUNDABLE regardless if the pet(s) are no longer living at the time of the owner's death, if the family of the deceased decides to keep the pet(s), or if the individual enrolling in the program later decides on another option for his/her pet(s).

How do you enroll?

1. Request and complete the enrollment form and review the details with the Director. We want to make absolutely certain we understand your pet's personality, medical condition, training, and other special needs or desires.
2. Make arrangements to have your Will revised to include the Peace of Mind Program. If necessary, our staff will work with you and your attorney to complete the arrangements.
3. Provide Fuzzy Friends Rescue with your enrollment form.
4. For estate plan provisions or life insurance gifts, make a copy for Fuzzy Friends. For cash gifts, simply send a check to FFR designated for the program.
5. Notify a friend, relative, neighbor, or the executor of your estate that your pet is enrolled in FFR's Peace of Mind Program. Provide them with FFR's phone numbers.
6. When a Peace of Mind Program enrollee is orphaned, any of the abovementioned contacts can notify the shelter. The shelter will immediately house the pet(s) and ensure that the pet's medical needs are met.

This is the first phase of what will ultimately be a full-fledged "life care center" live-in facility for animals enrolled in this program. .
